Apply to our lives

- In Mark 4:35-41, the disciples accused Jesus of negligence. Have you ever found yourself in a situation where you could relate to the disciples? If so, can you share your experience and the outcome of it?
- How does who is God, what he's already done for you, and the fact that he is with you "in the boat" come into play at the moment when you face your fears?
- How can your Discipleship Community support you in nurturing a deeper trust in God amidst doubt, uncertainty, and difficulties?
